The Department for the Study of Religion, University of Toronto invites applications from graduate students interested in teaching the following courses during the 2018-2019 Session at the St. George Campus. Applicants should submit (1) a current curriculum vitae, (2) an outline of the course, method of evaluation, and required textbook(s), and (3) evidence of teaching ability (e.g., summarized course evaluations, letters of reference, etc.). Duties: Include presenting two hours of lectures a week; conducting tutorials; grading papers and exams (including make-up examinations if required); and other pedagogical and administrative tasks associated with an undergraduate course.

Stipend: A full course from September –December 2018 is \$15,800 and a half course is \$7,900. A full course from January-April 2019 is \$16,116 and half course is \$8,058. This includes vacation pay. **Please note that should rates stipulated in the collective agreement vary from rates stated in this posting, the rates stated in the collective agreement shall prevail"**

Qualifications: M.A. in Religion; Ph.D. candidacy, significant graduate work and ongoing research in the specific field of the course to which application is being made.
